Candidates must pass a Written Exam and a Practical Examination in order to receive Accredited Certification.

The Written Examination consists of a Core Examination and a Specialty exam for any different type(s) of certification that the candidates are desiring to receive.

The Candidate will take a Practical Exam in order to demonstrate his or her skills of operating a Crane. The candidate will need to pass a Practical test for Each Crane they desire to operate.

Crane Operator Certification(s) are good for five years from the date that the first Practical or Written Examination is successfully completed with a Passing Score. **The Certification will renew for another 5 years if the operator(s) successfully pass their Written Examinations and can demonstrate that they have 1,000 hours of working with or around the crane in the 5 years of being Certified.**

All Purpose Crane Training will do a 2-3 day prep class before the written test. A practical test can be performed prior to or after the written test but must be completed 12 months after the written test. Refer to the **NCCCO Mobile Crane Candidate Handbook** for details.

Terms of Payment for services are due as follows: 50% due now prior to service and 50% due at the completion of service. Cancellation policy: \$150.00 fee for class canceled 8-11 business days prior to class, 50% for class canceled 4-7 business days prior to class and 100% for classes for classes canceled 1-3 business days prior to class.
